Supply Chain Investment Program Shares Outcomes from Completed Projects



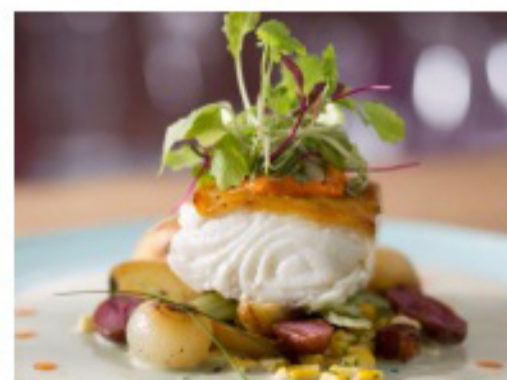
